Score your home across 6 systems and get a priority buy-order — no sales call required.

How to score

Rate each system 0-2: 0 = none/basic, 1 = partial, 2 = fully smart & integrated. Total out of 12.

System	What to check	Score (0-2)
Network & Wi-Fi	Mesh coverage, no dead zones, guest network	
Security & Cameras	Doorbell cam, entry sensors, remote arm/disarm	
Lighting	App/voice control, schedules, away-simulation	
Climate	Smart thermostat, room sensors, energy reports	
Entertainment & Audio	Whole-home audio, universal remote/voice control	
Appliances & Leak/Safety	Smart locks, water leak sensors, smoke/CO integration	

Score bands

- 0-4: Starter — begin with network + one high-impact system (usually security).
- 5-8: Growing — you have a foundation; focus on integration so systems talk to each other.
- 9-12: Advanced — refine automations and add redundancy/backup power for critical systems.

Priority map — fix in this order

- 1. Network (everything else depends on a solid mesh Wi-Fi backbone).
- 2. Security (highest safety return per dollar).
- 3. Climate (fastest payback via energy savings).
- 4. Lighting, then entertainment, then remaining safety sensors.

Buy-order budgeting rule

Spend roughly 40% network/security, 30% climate, 30% lighting+entertainment+safety on a first pass — rebalance after your 90-day usage review.
